Camaro Fest 2021



I know there is several members planning to attend. This is going to be their last show.

2021 Camaro Nationals

We are a month in, so I guess it is really here to stay....no going back....full speed ahead. Things are starting to look more promising; I know several people who have received their vaccinations, and others who are scheduled. In another month, things should be rolling along, and by summer people should be starting to relax. It won't be back to normal, but getting closer. What does that mean for the Car Hobby? *IT'S SHOW TIME!*

Yes, it's time to announce the 22nd ("Sort of" Annual) Camaro Nationals. Thursday evening June 24th thru Saturday afternoon June 26th will see

hundreds of Camaros descend on Frederick Maryland once again. There is a lot of "cooped up" energy out there, so don't be surprised if this is a big year for car show turn out.

The last year gave everyone lots of time to finish projects, detail cars, and think of improvements we could make to the show; and here are a few of them: Maryland Camaro Club members are not restricted to a specific MCC Class.

This allows MCC members to compete in larger more balanced classes.

"Participant Vote" is changing from 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place Awards to "Top 25" Awards.

This balances out some classes with only one or two cars, and others with 10 cars.

"Heartbeat" judging is still 200 points, but will be awarded with Gold, Silver, and Bronze Awards rather than 1st, 2nd & 3rd Place Awards. This will allow all cars to more evenly have a chance at an award, as the "Metal" awards are not limited to three per class.

Another benefit of this change, is that we no longer have to spend time classifying and moving cars on the show field to specific areas. As all Heartbeat Camaros will be judged only against a score sheet, the need to break Mild-Modified from Stock, etc, is no longer relevant. We will generally park cars by generation, but it is not a big deal if someone wants to park by a friend with a different gen Camaro.

Indoor Non-Judged will be a new class, for those who just want to hang and show off their beautiful Camaros, but who can't stand the thought of rain. Buildings 14 and 14A will have space designated for this class. (Obviously limited by space in the buildings.)

Every attempt will be made to hold the Banquet before the Auction, but if COVID restrictions prevent us from doing so, tickets fees will be refunded at the show, so don't be afraid to go ahead and put them on your registration form. We have two ideas for the Auction, in case there is an issue with the banquet – so bring along a few extra pennies.

Get your registration in, put a few masks in the Camaro, and

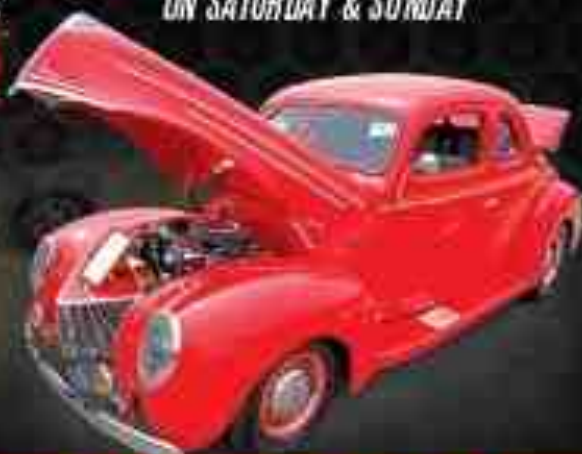
