### **HOT ROD Drag Week 2022**

For its 18th anniversary, HOT ROD Drag Week Presented by Gear Vendors Overdrive is returning to four classic drag strips to put America's fastest street-legal drag cars to the test. Sunday, September 18, 2022, is registration and tech day at Memphis International Raceway in Millington, Tennessee; will your street-legal drag car survive until Friday, September 23, 2022, in the world's most grueling endurance drag racing event?

HOT ROD Drag Week is the ultimate test for <u>street-legal drag racing cars</u>: Not only do competitors have to race on four different tracks over five consecutive days, they have to drive their race car between each venue on specified routes, with photo checkpoints, that average over 1,000 miles throughout the week. What's more, racers can only use the tools and parts they can carry in their car or in their optional trailer—towed by the race car.

HOT ROD Drag Week has inspired multiple dragand-drive events since its first year in 2005, and the community of racers the event has built is unlike any other. It's not uncommon for <a href="Drag Week">Drag Week</a> competitors to band together to help each other get through the week; loaning tools, sharing parts, even wrenching on the side of the road or through the night to help fellow racers get to the next track or make a pass.



# Here's The 2023 Chevy Camaro Production Start Date: Exclusive

The 2023 Chevy Camaro is slated to become the eighth model year of the latest sixth-generation nameplate, and now, *GM Authority* has uncovered the 2023 Chevy Camaro's production start date. According to *GM Authority* sources, the 2023 Chevy Camaro is scheduled to roll off the line starting June 6<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Production will once again take place at the GM Lansing Grand River Plant in Michigan, which also produces the Cadillac CT4 and Cadillac CT5 luxury sedans.

For now, it looks like the Chevy Camaro nameplate is starting to wind down, with development of the seventh-generation model terminated, making the current sixth generation the "final" generation. As *GM Authority* exclusively covered previously, the discontinuation timeframe for the sixth-generation Chevy Camaro is a moving target and has yet to be determined. Rumor has it the 2023 Chevy Camaro may offer the same naturally aspirated 6.2L V8 LT2 gasoline engine as the C8 Chevy Corvette Stingray, with the LT2 replacing the naturally aspirated 6.2L V8 LT1 gasoline engine for the 2023 Chevy Camaro

engine lineup. While there are several reasons why this may be a possibility, including lower emissions, renewed interest in the nameplate, and higher sales, there's also several reasons why the rumor is likely untrue, including certification costs, engineering, testing, and validation costs, and high demand for the C8 Corvette Stingray, currently the only production model to offer the LT2 engine.

Although the production start date for the 2023 Chevy Camaro is now locked in, the longterm plans for the Chevy Camaro remain somewhat murky. It's possible that General Motors will extend the lifecycle of the current sixth-generation model to the 2026 model year. As a reminder, the sixth-generation vehicle was introduced for the 2016 model year. Another possibility is that the Chevy Camaro nameplate will be applied to a completely different vehicle, namely an all-electric performance sedan that follows GM's pivot towards zero-emissions vehicles.
