Renderings Show Gen Six Chevy Camaro Sedan Would Have Looked Great

Production of the sixth-generation Chevy Camaro concluded with the end of the 2024 model year, much to the chagrin of enthusiasts. While the sixth-generation Camaro was offered strictly as a two-door coupe and convertible, GM Authority has long toyed with the idea of a Camaro sedan. Now, we're back at it with a fresh set of exclusive renderings.



he last time we rendered a hypothetical sixth-gen Chevy Camaro was back in 2019, but this time around, we're taking another crack at it with improved illustrative skills.

From the off, the front end of our Chevy Camaro sedan is still instantly recognizable, carrying over the same sharp headlights, wide grille, and aggressive lower fascia. The long hood and sculpted lines give it a performance-oriented stance, while details like hood vents and racing stripes reinforce its muscle car identity.

One of the biggest changes is the extended roofline, which flows smoothly into the rear with four full doors. The proportions maintain the Camaro's athletic look, avoiding the boxy appearance of other sedan conversions.



In profile, the transformation becomes more obvious. The wheelbase is lightly stretched to accommodate rear passengers, resulting in a longer, more balanced silhouette. Despite the added length, the design keeps a low roof and tight body lines, preserving the inherent coupe-like character. Flush doors and subtle styling lines help to integrate the extra doors, while large wheels and low-profile tires maintain the performance-focused appearance. At the rear, the rendering shows off a pair of slim taillights, a subtle decklid spoiler, and a pronounced rear diffuser. Quad exhaust outlets emphasize performance, while the wider stance gives the sedan a planted attitude.



As a reminder, the sixth-generation Chevy Camaro rode on the GM Alpha platform, while at the top of the range, the high-performance Camaro ZL1 featured the supercharged 6.2L V8 LT4 rated at 650 horsepower and 650 pound-feet of torque, paired with either the GM six-speed manual or the GM 10-speed automatic. Stuffed into a four-door body, that's exactly the sort of performance that would make purists think twice before criticizing this "grocery getter."
